

Session Two: The Show don't Tell Method & Go-To Phrases

Summary

Objective: Introduction of the "Show Don't Tell" method - how to write engaging stories to convey a message. The importance of using phrases to hook a reader. This is the artistic part of the workshop, preparing the participants to engage in writing their final blog post assignment.

Time Allotment: 90 minutes

Implementation

- **0-30 minutes: Short discussion about the Session 1 homework.** An introduction of the "Show Don't Tell" method. What is it, how do we use it and what are some examples of good writing? Practical exercise: describe a character with the help of the method. We will be looking at examples to do so.
- **30-50 minutes:** Using good grammar and vocabulary to write an engaging text. Why is it so important and how to we get the best out of phraseology? A part of having excellent grammar and vocabulary is knowing when and how to use phrases. Here, we will introduce a list of phrases to the participants and look at practical example sentences.
- **50-90 minutes:** Practical Exercises, Discussion about phrases
